## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

### ENROLLMENT FEE

The total cost, including insurance:

- \$15.00 for the College Age Retreat
- \$50.00 for all other camp sessions

The registration fee is \$10.00 (this will be applied toward the total cost), and this fee will only be returned if the prospective camper is unable to attend because of illness. An additional late fee of \$10.00 will be assessed if the registration is postmarked after June 21, 2019, for Senior Week and Secondary Week, and after July 5, 2019, for Junior Week. We are able to accept only a limited number of campers each session, so early registration is encouraged.

### HEALTH AND SAFETY

Every precaution will be taken to ensure the health and safety of each camper. A nurse or camp health director will be on the campsite, and a hospital is located 20 minutes from the campsite.

Every camper must present the required medical form which must be SIGNED BY HIS/HER PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN.

### FINAL BULLETIN

A final bulletin and the required medical form will be mailed to all who register. The bulletin will provide directions to the campsite, a list of necessary equipment, the camp's rules and dress code regulations, and other important information. Please read the final bulletin carefully, as it will contain more complete information than can be provided in this brochure.

### AGE OF CAMPERS

To be eligible to attend a particular week of camp, a camper must be the appropriate age by the final day of the week that he/she plans to attend. A camper who wishes to enroll in a week in which he/she is not the appropriate age must receive permission from the appropriate Camp Director, and then he/she may be accepted on a conditional basis.

### ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE TIMES

#### College Age Retreat

Arrival: Friday, 5:30 - 6:30PM

Departure: Sunday, 12:00 noon - 1:00PM

#### All other sessions

Arrival: Sunday, 3:30 - 5:00PM

Departure: Saturday, 10:00AM - 11:30AM

### CANTEEN ACCOUNT

Each camper should deposit spending money (for snacks, crafts, etc.) into a canteen account upon arrival. All unspent money will be refunded during check-out on Saturday. \$15 is the suggested amount for snacks; however, more might be needed for t-shirts, crafts, etc.

### CAMPER CONDUCT

A camper who disobeys the camp rules may be subject to dismissal from camp. A camper who is dismissed will not be permitted to return to camp the following year without the written consent of the Board of Directors.

### DRESS CODE

Dress must be appropriate and modest at all times.

The guidelines below must be followed:

- Shorts must be at least half the length of the wearer's thigh.
- Campers must be fully dressed in all common areas.
- No extremely tight clothing.
- No cleavage-baring and/or midriff-baring shirts.
- No camisoles or tank tops with thin straps or spaghetti straps.
- All underwear must be covered by clothing at all times.

More details regarding the dress code and its enforcement will be included in the final bulletin. Please read that section carefully and pack accordingly.

### LEAVING THE CAMPSITE

No one may leave camp without permission from the Camp Director. Permission will not be granted to leave camp for concerts or similar activities.

### ITEMS NOT PERMITTED

The possession and/or use of certain items will not be permitted. This includes, but is not necessarily limited to the following:

- Tobacco, alcohol, and other drugs
- Weapons
- **CELL PHONES**
- TVs, DVD players, Tablets & any other device with internet access, large stereos, refrigerators and air-conditioning units
- Computers, laptops, and video games (hand-held or console)

### VISITORS

Camp Concern strives to create an environment that is free from distractions and disruptions, so please consider that when making decisions regarding visiting. If, however, you plan to visit, you must honor the camp rules and schedule.
